

Varun cards best

Varun Parikh shot a best card of 5-over par to win the gross at the Kensville Amateur Challenge tournament played at Kensville Golf & Country Club. Jyotin Gor was declared the best overall winner in the Stableford format.

It wasn't easy for Varun as his friends Anshul Patel and Kairav Shah also put up a decent show. However, Varun's three birdies made the difference and he won in gross score.

In the Stableford category, Gor won the overall net prize. Playing to a 14 handicap, Gor played an excellent round to accumulate 41 Stableford points. He was closely followed by Niraj Kapur, who carded 40 Stableford points.

Siddharth Naik won the 0-14 category with 36 points and Munish Patell was the runner up with 34 points. Pravit Parikh and Pranav Kapadia were tied at 38 points in the 15-28 handicap category. Pravit won the title on the count back of the last three holes. Reenu Nirwani played steadily to win the la-



dies category with 37 points, while Hetal Patel was the runner up with 34 points.

The juniors' category also saw a tie between Mohnish Shah and Aaradhana Vaghela. Mohnish won on the count back. Aaradhana was the only junior to hit a birdie in the round and was specially rewarded for this effort.

In the skill prizes, Sameer Sinha took home the longest drive honours at 251 yards, and Tushar Shah was closest to pin (9').
