

Big B gets new address in town

After Tendulkar, Amitabh Bachchan gets a plot at a golf course near Ahmedabad

Amitabh Bachchan has a new place in town. The veteran actor has been gifted a plot in the 700-acre Kensville Golf and Country Club, located about 40 km south of Ahmedabad.

The tract of land is reportedly at court no 5. This is the only functional 18-hole golf course in Gujarat which has a residential township planned around it. The actor is not the only celebrity to have got land here. 2,000-square yard plot of land was recently registered in master blaster Sachin Tendulkar's name. The cricketer is expected to build a villa here shortly.

endorsed by golfer Jeev Milkha Singh, whose villa is already under construction at the entrance of the course.

Cricketer Parthiv Patel, too, has a plot here. Kensville director Jaxay Shah refused to comment about the Big B deal. However, a company official confirmed the news. Re-

fusing to be named, he said, "We were in talks with the Bachchans. The plot was finalised long back but as the Bachchans had not finalised anything, nothing was announced. The deal was confirmed on Wednesday when the actor came here to inaugurate the Gujarat Kensville Challenge."
